Hours of Operation

Our program runs Monday – Friday beginning at 3:00pm; pick up time is at **6:45pm** on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with the exception of **5:45pm** on Wednesday. Our program is closed throughout the month of December, we will reopen on the first day of school in January.

Membership Fees

Membership is **\$150.00** per school year; for your convenience we have three payment plan options

Late pick-up Fee

Late pick-ups will result in a \$10.00 late fee which must be paid on the day of the late pick-up. In the event of a late pick-up, parents will be given one verbal warning, after that they will be charged the late fee. Continuous late pick-ups will result in your child being suspended from the program for 2 days. Our staff do understand that delays are sometimes unavoidable, if this happens please call our staff to let them know you will be running late.

Important Notices

- We encourage your child(ren) to travel to and from the Children's After School program with friends or siblings. We also offer the Walking Bus for child(ren) attending Village Union (Weather Permitted). If interested, please contact staff to set your child up with our Walking Bus Program.
- Members 12 years of age and over will be permitted to walk home alone ONLY if signed permission has been completed and on file.
- Signed permission forms must be on file if anyone other than the child(rens) parent are to pick them up. Please let us know if there is anyone who is NOT to pick up your child/ren.
- Please ensure to carefully read your child's monthly program schedule so you are aware of any special dates or changes within the program.
 - ➤ If your child is ill please do not send them to the After School Program. This will help control and prevent the spread of illness amongst staff, other children and volunteers. If your child is too sick to attend school then they are too sick to attend the Children's After-School Program.
 - > If your child does not attend school, they cannot attend the After-School Program.
- We will be doing head lice checks regularly, if your child is found to have head lice they will be asked to stay home from the program until it is treated and proof of clearance is provided.
- We understand that some children may have dietary restrictions. If a child is unable to eat the meal that is being provided it is the parent/guardians responsibility to make other meal arrangements for their child. All meals will be shared on the programs monthly schedule prior to the first day of the month.
- The first Wednesday of the month the After-School program will be going swimming at the Eastview Boys and Girls Club. Please ensure your child has their bathing suit as well as towel with them every Wednesday. All programming will be closed on swim days.
